Here is something I do in my display someone might like to try.  
Making a Tunnel with a mirror backing.  
Go to Lowes (or any Lighting store) and look at the packing between the lights, this came from a circle light.



you can see right away it would make a great gate for a castle, anyway cut out the doors, then make a box with styro.



Using a mirror as the back wall and the gate as the front. I like to have the sides about 3" wide, I used duct tape to hold everything together, it was handy.



next I placed where I wanted it and



covered it with plaster cloth.(find at Michael's)  
Then take a small tree and put inside in a corner up front, the mirror will pick it up and looks like it's down the way.  
angle the mirror so it's below you line of sight.

You can also cut a paper roll to pass between hills like a round tunnel or cut it at an angle



to have it coming up or going down to another level
