Subject: RE:Building of a display

Dan: would you add these pictures to my tunnel site.

How I am building my NP display which is in a "L" shape 12' X '8' with the cabinets in place I have to put on a top of plywood



Next I have to put some supports on the back to hold the mountains. The mountains are made using a 1/2" styro with scrap styro hot glued and covered with a plaster and paper towel mix. then spray painted with Blue and Black.





Then I used screws to go through the mountains to the supports and raised the mountains up off the tables.



Now it's time to place the styro to form the shape of the display. I'm using styro scraps of 1/2" to 4" to build up the display.



This way I can drop light cords down through the styro where ever I want them. By using the 4" styro there is enough support to carry all the weight I need. Later this will be covered with a Plaster cloth and painted White with the glitter applied while it is wet. Lots of place for tunnels to get from one place to the other or caves.
